


This project is designed in such a way that every devotee can participate in this plantation in various ways.

# Sri Raghavendranugraha Award



Mahamahopadhyaya Vidwan Sri P.S. Lakshminarayana Upadhyaya (Posthomously)

Vidwan Sri P.S. Lakshminarayana Upadhyaya was a Versatile, multifaceted Research Scholar. His scholarly rapport sets no geographical limitation. He was an exponent in Philosophy, Logic, Grammar and Astrology. Despite having such an extraordinary talent Sri Upadhyaya stands unique by his

humble characters. The then pontiff of our Srimatha Sri Sujayeendra Teertha empowered the literature works of Srimatha by appointing him as a Resident Scholar of the institution. Sri Upadhyaya served the post till His last days. Under his monitorship only the Panchanga of Srimatha was started. Sri Gurusarvabhouma Magazine of Srimatha was also started under his stewardship. He has translated the magnum works of Sanskrit "Sumadhva Vijaya, Sri Raghavendra Vijaya, Sadachara Smruti, Usha Harana, Sri Ramacharitra Manjari and Sri Krishna Charitraya Manjari interestingly into Kannada Language. He has also authored several independent works like Sri Raghavendra Suprabhata, Sri Raghavendra Gadya and many hymns on Sri Raghavendra Gurusarvabhouma.

Sri Upadhaya has bagged numerous awards including President's Award for his collective works. His Holiness Sri Suyateendra Teertha Swamiji deems it fit to honour him Posthumously by presenting Sri Raghavendra Anugraha Award of this year.



Sri Sudheendra and Sri Waman are a service oriented pair. They are lucky to be born in a culturally rich family of Sri Krishnamurthy and Smt. Saroja. Their ancestors are well known Scholars. Their immense devotion on Sri Rayaru is



inherited. It is because of humble devotion on Sri Rayaru that the brothers are of higher caliber today. Both have been closely associated with Srimatha for the past several decades and actively participating in all developments. Despite offering contributions liberally in a huge quantity Sudheendra and Waman never wanted to come into the light of publicity. However it is worthy

to mention the following two examples of their generousness. They have contributed the Golden Pallakki that serves Sri Rayaru every day at Mantralaya. At present the Kumbhakonam matha is being renovated in all dimensions with generous contributions of Sri Sudheendra and Sri Warnan.
